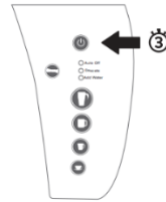

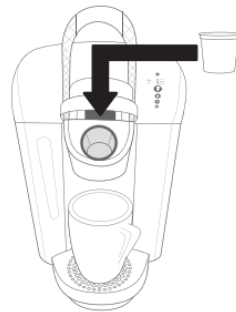


Keurig

1. To fill machine, remove the water reservoir from brewer by first removing lid from reservoir, then lift reservoir straight up and away from brewer (may be tight). Fill to MAX FILL line with fresh water. Replace reservoir on brewer and cover with lid.
2. Press power button — the green power light and Auto Off light will illuminate. The brewer will automatically begin heating the water. This will take about 3 minutes. Once the heating sound stops, the brewer is ready.



3. Place a mug on the drip tray plate.
4. Lift the silver handle to insert your selected K-Cup. Lower the handle completely to close the lid.
NOTE: Do not remove the foil lid or puncture the K-Cup.



5. Select your brew size – for bolder coffee, press the Strong button before selecting your brew size. The brew size and Strong button, if selected, will remain illuminated while brewing – about 1 minute.

If the brewer does not brew, lift and re-lower handle, check water levels and make sure the water reservoir is properly inserted.
