



CFP FAQ

How long does my talk need to be?

Your talk is scheduled for a 45-minute slot. We recommend planning for a 40-minute presentation, allowing the remaining 5 minutes for Q&A at the end.

Can I submit an abstract for more than one topic?

Yes, you can submit a second abstract. However, you cannot do it on the same form. You will need to start the process over and fill out a second CFP form and submit a separate abstract.

Can I still submit an abstract after the Call for Papers closed?

No, you cannot. Our committee reviews 100+ abstracts every year and will begin the process as soon as the Call for Papers closes. Please do not reach out to them to submit a late entry.

When will I know if my talk has been selected?

We will reach out to you on or before **June 30, 2026**. If you are not selected, you will receive an email informing you of the decision.

Can I add a co-speaker after my talk has been selected?

You may add an approved co-speaker until August 15, 2026. Any additions or changes of speakers after this date will not be reflected in any conference materials.

Can I make any changes once my abstract has been submitted?

Yes, but only between when you submit your abstract and **May 31, 2026**. You will need to log into your Submission Portal to edit your abstract.

Do I have to pay for my conference registration if I'm selected to speak?

No. If you are selected either as a speaker or a speaker in reserve, you will need to RSVP via the email link provided. That will then give you access to the Speaker Portal where you can secure your registration as a speaker at no charge.

If I'm selected, will CYBR.SEC.CON. pay for my travel and lodging?

No, CYBR.SEC.CON. does not cover these costs for speakers who are selected through the Call for Papers.
