Onno Dijkstra is a principal consultant at Fugro NL Land B.V., Groningen, the Netherlands. Onno works for Fugro since 1986, starting as a geotechnical engineer. From 1992 to 2015 he headed Fugro's regional office in Groningen, which he expanded from 10 to 30 employees. Since 2012, after the M3.6 Huizinge earthquake, the gas mining in Groningen became a major issue and since 2016 he is a principal geotechnical consultant and the coordinator of all mining related activities in the Netherlands. Onno contributes to the Governmental Knowledge Program Effects of Mining since 2017.

Onno's knowledge and experience consists of investigating the subsurface and groundwater, the design of foundations, construction pits and ground structures and carrying out and interpreting monitoring. For complex inner-city projects he can determine the most optimal geotechnical design and the risks. Onno has extensive experience in investigating disasters and building damage.
