## GETTING HERE



Here are the best options + average travel times for getting to the conference hotel:

- **From LAX:**

- Uber/Lyft/Cab: 30 min; \$60-80
- Public Transportation, 1.5 hrs; \$1.75 one way:
  - Take metro connector to LAX/Metro Transit Ctr
  - Take Metro C Line (green) to Norwalk Station
  - Exit Willowbrook/Rosa Parks (8 stops)
  - Take Metro A Line (blue) to Downtown Long Beach
  - Exit 1<sup>st</sup> street (9 stops, Platform 2)
  - 0.2 mi walk to Westin Long Beach

- **From Long Beach Airport (LGB):**

- Uber/Lyft/Driving: 12-20 min; \$30
- Public Transportation, \$1.25:
  - Bus: 111 (red line) LKWD-Bdwy to Downtown
  - Exit First & Long Beach Blvd NE (39 stops)
  - 0.1 mi walk to hotel

- **From John Wayne/Orange County Airport (SNA):**

- Uber/Lyft/Driving: 40 min; \$50
- Public Transportation not recommended due to limited options crossing county lines (OC to LA)





### Queen Mary






## NOTABLE ATTRACTIONS




### Disneyland!


