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
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
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

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MESSAGE FROM THE PRESIDENT

The theme of this year's convention is *From Crowds to Clouds: Psychology of Groups in the Digital Era*. This theme is especially meaningful to me because it reflects my own research journey, from an early interest in face-to-face groups to a deeper focus on virtual collaboration, collective creativity, and group performance in digital environments. Psychology has always been deeply concerned with how people think, relate, influence one another, and work together in groups. What has changed is the setting. Increasingly, our groups no longer gather only in traditional classrooms, boardrooms, or around tables; they also come together in virtual meeting spaces, shared digital workspaces, online communities, and AI-supported environments. The basic psychological processes remain fundamentally human, yet the contexts in which they are expressed are evolving rapidly. This makes the psychology of groups in the digital era an especially timely and important area for reflection, discussion, and research.

We are honored to welcome an outstanding group of keynote speakers from different parts of the country. Together, this year's keynote speakers bring a remarkable range of perspectives to the program. **Dr. Mahzarin Banaji** (Harvard University) will address implicit social cognition and the ways hidden biases shape judgments and opportunities. **Dr. Paul Paulus** (University of Texas at Arlington) will speak on group creativity in the digital and artificial intelligence age, focusing on collaboration and innovation across in-person and technology-supported settings. **Dr. Shinobu Kitayama** (University of Michigan) will present the cultural psychology of group identity and the relationship between interdependence and self-promotion in collective life. **Dr. Verlin Hinsz** (North Dakota State University) will discuss how groups think, feel, and decide, helping us understand how individual thoughts and preferences are transformed into shared group responses. In addition, we will feature **Dr. Jasmine Hammer** (Scottish Rite for Children in Dallas), generously sponsored by the Woodcock Institute, who will present on the neuropsychology of memory and learning.

Our affiliate organizations also have an excellent lineup of invited speakers. Psi Chi will feature **Dr. Kathleen Bogart** (Oregon State University), who will speak on what psychologists should know about ableism and why disability must be included in our conversations about diversity, research, and advocacy. SWToP will feature **Sue Frantz** (New Mexico State University), whose talk will consider what an introductory psychology course should truly teach if we want it to matter in students' lives. Collectively, these speakers and presenters bring a wide range of expertise that enrich our program and remind us of the many ways psychology contributes to research, teaching, practice, and public life.

To support and advance SWPA's mission to promote and strengthen psychology's scientific, professional and educational facets, we have been committed to providing Continuing Education opportunities. Drs. Michael Gottlieb, Jim Olson, Huong Vo, and Jenna Moore will be presenting invited continuing education workshops. 

Collaborative Creativity: The Past and the Future in the Age of AI
Frisco 1-2, Friday, 9:00 am – 10:00 am

Collaborative innovation is more important than ever with all the challenges we face in our lives, the country, and the world. Many problems require multiple areas of expertise, motivated participants and the ability to work together effectively to come up with potential creative and effective solutions. However, many collaborative innovation efforts involve temporary groups with limited prior history trying to solve nontechnical open-ended problems and who have little understanding of optimal process for their efforts. I will discuss research on in person and electronic group creativity that has provided much guidance for this process, brainstorming sessions and effective meetings in general. The talk will highlight the best practices and their theoretical grounding, which can result in groups tapping the best ideas from the “group brain” and developing them into a useful plan. I will also discuss the potential positive and negative impact of AI on the collaborative innovation process and on individual and societal functioning.

Implicit Social Cognition

All humans genuinely intend to obey the virtues of accuracy and fairness, but research from experimental psychology has consistently challenged the possibility that we, in fact, do so. We have learned that our actions can be inconsistent with our values – obstructing the very goals to which we are consciously and even passionately committed. A striking example of this state of affairs is that even if conscious prejudice/animus is genuinely absent, behavior can be disjointed from values of accuracy and fairness because of implicit bias (a term to emerge from our lab in the early 1990s, and that has now entered the vernacular).

This lecture will focus on the surprising and even perplexing manner by which implicit bias operates. By walking the 40-year research path of my lab, I will elucidate how I came to understand what implicit bias is, its role in shaping life’s opportunities and outcomes and reactionary challenges to it; as well, an optimistic result I did not expect to encounter in my lifetime – that even implicit (hidden) biases are reliably and at times rapidly moving toward neutrality. I will touch on the signature behavioral result of dissociation and association between explicit and implicit cognition, the neural underpinnings of implicit bias, its development from childhood into adulthood, its malleability, its power to predict socially significant outcomes in the domains of health, education, employment and legal treatment at the regional level. I will point to new research on the manifestation of bias in large language corpora and in LLMs today. The overarching call of this work is a simple one: to deeply understand implicit cognition so that we can do what we have done, as a species, so many times before in our history: to outsmart the limits of our own minds to ensure that our consciously held values are transduced into a more praiseworthy world.

How Groups Think, Feel, and Decide

Groups are social facts of life. From the cradle to the grave, we are born into and borne by groups. In between, we live, work, and strive to thrive in these groups. The fundamental questions to be addressed in this presentation are “How are characteristics of group members (their thoughts, feelings, preferences) combined and transformed to result in a shared group response?” A theory of combinations of contributions aids consideration by helping to identify which characteristics are combined and transformed as well as specify in what manner the characteristics are combined and transformed. This leads to the adage that groups are context sensitive, and context situated. Moreover, dominant processing strategies are important for understanding how groups think, feel and decide -- particularly that the dominant processing strategies are exaggerated in these groups. The ways that groups think, feel, and decide will thus be revealed as these questions are considered.

The Cultural Psychology of Group Identity: Insights from Sub-Saharan Africa
 Frisco 1-2, Saturday, 2:00 pm – 3:00 pm

Sub-Saharan Africa (SSA) is becoming increasingly central to global business, politics, and culture. Despite its extraordinary linguistic and ethnic diversity, two core themes appear to underlie much of this variation. The first is a strong form of interdependence, marked by deep commitments to ingroup identities. The second is a cultural emphasis on self-promotion, characterized by the active and often competitive pursuit of personal success. Uniquely, these two forces are not merely coexisting—they are dynamically integrated: the pursuit of self-interest is widely seen as a vital way to contribute to collective flourishing. In this talk, I introduce and explore this hitherto overlooked system of self-promotive interdependence. Drawing on recent empirical findings from across SSA, I compare this model with cultural patterns observed in other major world regions—including the Middle East and North Africa, East Asia, Latin America, and the West. I argue that this distinctive integration of self-promotion and interdependence helps illuminate the unique structure and function of group identity in SSA.

Memory and learning skills are critical for various aspects of life such as work, academics, and socialization. The current talk will define memory and the associated neuroanatomy networks. In addition to this, the talk will discuss variables that impact memory such as stress, emotions, attention/executive functioning as well as confounding medical differences. Given the complex nature of memory, neuropsychological evaluations can often be beneficial in identifying a pattern of strengths and weaknesses for a person as well as providing individualized recommendations. The Journey from Crowds to Clouds: Group Psychology, Lived and Tested

Many of us are part of groups long before we ever pause to think about them. We are shaped by families, communities, classrooms, and cultures that teach us how to belong, how to relate, and how to make decisions with others. Group decision making and collective problem solving were not topics I simply encountered as a researcher. They were realities I lived out of necessity while making some of the most important decisions in my life. In that sense, my interest in groups is not only academic. It is also personal, and I suspect that is true for many of us. Even when we think of ourselves as independent decision makers, our lives are often shaped through conversations, negotiations, support systems, and shared choices with others. Today, the spaces in which groups interact are changing rapidly. Increasingly, collaboration happens not only in physical settings, but also in virtual meetings, digital workspaces, online communities, and AI-supported environments.

This talk is an invitation to think about group psychology not simply as a topic within psychology, but as one of the most urgent areas for psychology's future. Drawing from my own research, my lived experience, and the work of others, I examine what remains constant in group psychology, what changes when interaction moves online, and why the study of groups remains especially important in the digital era. At its core, this talk is grounded in a simple idea: progress does not happen alone, creativity does not happen alone, strong communities are not built alone, and the future will not be built alone. As our shared lives move from crowds to clouds, psychology has an essential role to play in understanding and improving the future of human connection.
