

36TH ANNUAL SAN ANTONIO OPEN GOLF CHAMPIONSHIP

Benefiting the Texas Research Society on Alcoholism

DATE: Saturday and Sunday, November 22-23, 2025

LOCATION: Cedar Creek Golf Course, San Antonio, Texas

ENTRY DEADLINE: Wednesday, November 19th, 6 pm Central

COMPETITION: 36 holes, individual stroke play, according to USGA Rules of Golf

Because of limited daylight this time of year, the field will be cut to the low 100 players after the first round. Those who do not make the cut will be given a certificate for a round of golf and a small bucket of range balls for a later date.

ELIGIBILITY: Open to professionals & amateurs, men and women.

Amateurs must have a certifiable handicap of 8 or less.

ENTRY FEE: Professionals - \$450 Amateurs - \$225

(Includes green fees & range balls. **Cart not included.** Only 2 carts are allowed per pairing.)

CANCELLATION POLICY: 8 days prior to tournament = full refund;

4-7 days prior (Saturday-Tuesday) = 80% refund; 3 days prior (Wednesday) or less = no refund.

Conditions of play and the purses for the 2025 San Antonio Open

1. There will be three teeing grounds.
 - a. Blue tees - amateurs and professionals
 - b. White tees - senior professionals, senior amateurs, women amateurs, and women professionals
 - c. Gold tees - super senior amateurs, senior women amateurs and professionals
2. There will be separate purses for each category of players.
 - a. Professional Cash Purse - Male and Female Professionals
 - b. Amateur Merchandise Purse - Male and Female Amateurs
 - c. Senior Professional Cash Purse - Senior Male and Female Professionals
 - d. Senior Amateur Merchandise Purse - Male and Female Senior Amateurs
 - e. Super Senior Merchandise Purse - Male and Female Super Amateurs
3. A player in any category may play in the next category up
Senior amateur and senior professional men and women may play from the blue teeing grounds and compete for those purses only. Players may only play for 1 category of purse.
4. As a result, the 2025 SA Open will feature 5 player divisions: Professionals, Amateurs, Senior Pros, Senior Amateurs, and Super Senior Amateurs.
5. Each category will have its own, separate purse.
6. The purse for each division is based on the number of players and tournament expenses.
7. Part of the entry fee of each player will be applied to (1) green fees (\$45/player/day, (2) contribution to the TRSA fellowship, and (3) expenses of the tournament (scoreboards, radio rental, food for the Rules group, etc.)
8. Bottom Line: Based on number of players, the purses below are based on total of 100 players (45 pros, 3 senior pros, 40 amateurs, 10 senior amateurs, 5 super senior amateurs. Adjustments will be made if more or fewer players are in a division. 25% to 30% of the players in each division will receive either cash or merchandise prizes.
9. All proceeds after expenses will be returned to the players as cash or merchandise.
