At a meeting called pursuant to Statute in such case made and provided the citizens of the Village of Battle Creek and vicinity assembled at the usual place of holding public worship in said Village on the 10th day of April A.D. 1837. for the purpose of forming a religious Society - Whereupon Moses Hall, Joseph Young, and Cephas A. Smith were duly elected Trustees to be called and known by the name of the Trustees of the first Congregational Society of Battle Creek
