Mr. Crumrine: 26 years in Marshall

This year's staff would like to dedicate the 1973 Dial to Mr. William Crumrine. Mr. Crumrine has worked in the Marshall school system since the fall of 1947 when he began teaching in the Science Department. He later became principal in 1965. He has also been guidance director and assistant principal at MHS. Prior to moving to Marshall he taught science, math and boys' physical education, and coached football in Greensprings, Ohio from 1939-41. He enlisted in the U.S. Air Force and served from 1941 to June 1946. From 1946-1947 he taught chemistry, physics, and math at Albion High where he was also the assistant baseball coach. Mr. Crumrine is a member of

the Historical Society, Lutheran Church, and Veterans.














