Since March 2011, Zakat Foundation of America has provided over \$5M in humanitarian aid to Syrians since the violence began.

Syrian Humanitarian Relief Highlights Timeline

### MAR 2011

- > ZF begins Syrian Humanitarian Relief campaign in Syria and surrounding countries of Jordan, Lebanon and Turkey



### JULY-AUG 2011 Ramadan

- > ZF Executive Director visited Turkey & distributed food packages

### OCT 2011

- > Second health clinic opened in Akkar, Lebanon



### NOV 2011 Udhya/Qurbani

- > Udhya/Qurbani Distribution



### DEC 2011

- > 40-foot shipping container valued at \$150k delivered to Syrian Refugees in Turkey

### JAN 2012

- > Blanket and Clothing distribution program in Turkey



### APRIL 2012

- > Begin Orphan Sponsorship Program in Syria

### MAY 2012

- > Begin providing housing for Syrians and refugees in Turkey, Jordan and Lebanon



### JUNE 2012

- > ZF Executive Director visits Syria, Jordan, Turkey and Lebanon



### JULY-AUG 2012 RAMADAN

- > Ramadan Distribution

### AUG 2012

- > Aug 26 sent the first food packages truck to Syria



### OCT 2012 Udhya/Qurbani

- > 50,000 beneficiaries

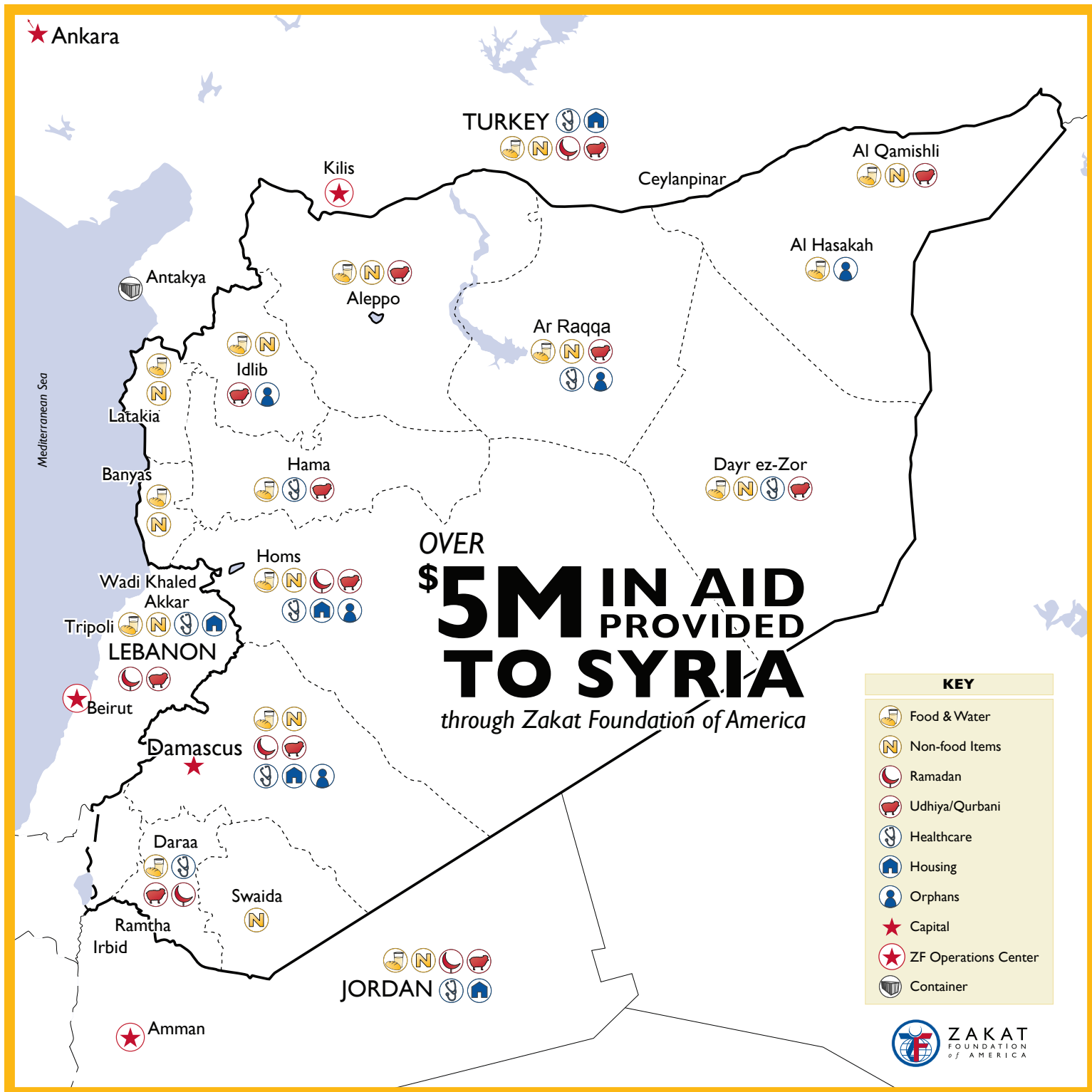


- > Blankets for Syrians campaign begins

### NOV 2012

- > Winter items & blankets distribution
- > Water filter distribution in camps in Turkey and Syria





**Since March 2011, ZF's work has included:**

- > Aiding seven field clinics and supporting field hospitals.
- > Ambulance operating in Kilis, Turkey and Ceylanpınar, Turkey.
- > Two ZF run medical clinics that offer free care for Syrian refugees in Lebanon. The first clinic opened in Wadi Khaled. The second medical clinic in Akkar, Lebanon. Distributing first aid kits and other medical supplies to civilians in Homs, Syria.
- > Running an Orphan Sponsorship Program for Syrian orphan children.
- > Providing housing to hundreds of displaced families in Syria, Jordan, Turkey and Lebanon. We are providing housing for 500 people in Damascus and Homs. We currently have 100 homes in Jordan, 10 homes in Turkey and 150 homes in Lebanon, providing a safe place to live for more than 1,200 displaced Syrians.
- > Dispatching five trucks, each loaded with 1,000 food packages, to cities inside Syria: Aleppo, Syria—two, Idlib, Syria—one, Hama, Syria—one and Kilis, Turkey—one for Syrian refugees. Distributing necessities including refrigerators, cooking gas, mattresses and blankets. Distribution took place in Homs, Damascus, Aleppo, Idlib, Lebanon, Turkey and Jordan to more than 2,000 families. ■
