PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT

**AUTOMATIC DISH WASHING MACHINE**

Rinse Aid should be used with a correctly installed dispenser. Fitted into an automatic dish washing machine. Refer to your user manual for correct dispensing units.



To get optimum results with your Rinse Aid make sure there is no residue left from your Clear wash or from soiled water. If you have chemical residue, you will need to adjust your dispensing unit.

**HEALTH & SAFETY**

- Refer to Safety Data Sheet (SDS) before use.
- Do not allow product to come into contact with skin & eyes.
- If chemical comes into contact with eyes, rinse with sterilised water or saline for at least 15 minutes, and seek medical attention.
- If chemical comes into contact with skin, wash affected area quickly and thoroughly, and seek medical attention.
- Avoid breathing mist & vapours.
- Wash hands after use.
- Wear protective clothing, gloves & chemical goggles.
- Do not mix with other chemicals, only mix with water.
- If poisoning occurs, do not induce vomiting. Seek medical attention.
- Keep out of reach from children.

**STORAGE**

- Store in a dry place, tightly sealed.
- Protect from sunlight and away from other materials.
- **KEEP AWAY FROM ACIDS AND CORROSIVE SUBSTANCES.**

**SPILL INSTRUCTIONS**

Slippery when spilt. To avoid accidents, clean up immediately. Wear protective equipment to prevent skin and eye contact and breathing in vapours. Work up wind or increase ventilation. Contain - prevent run off from entering drains and waterways. Collect spill using absorbent material (soil, sand or other inert material), then seal in properly labelled containers or drums for disposal.
