Twenty-five lessons with full-color stickers introduce and review Bible stories for children aged 4–6.

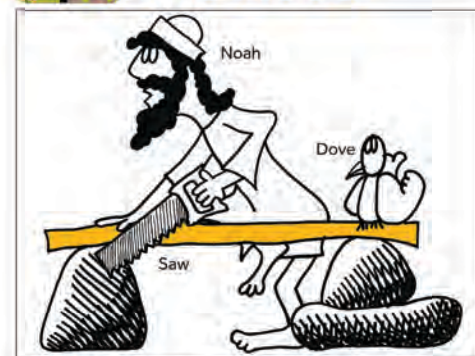
Beginning with creation of the world and ending with Moses' death, the twenty-five *Child's Garden of Torah* lessons cover the major stories you want young children to learn.

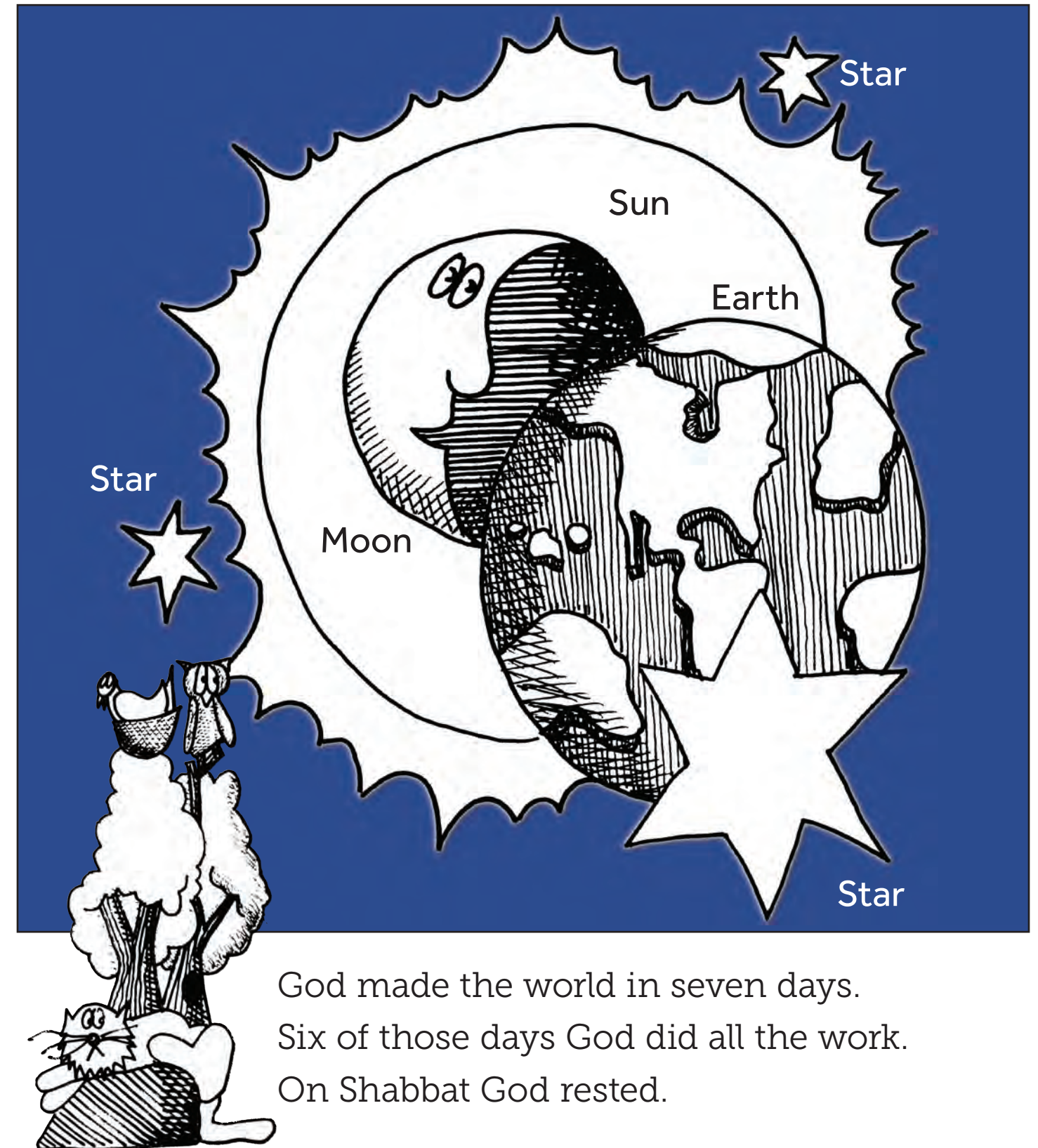

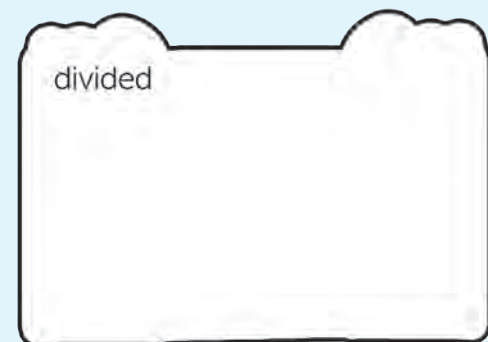


God made the world in seven days.
