Self-Directed and Mutual Fund accounts

- TD Self-Directed Account (RRSP/TFSA/Margin) \$25/Quarter (waived if total household assets exceed \$15,000)
- Mutual Fund Account (RRSP/TFSA/Cash) no fee.
- E-Series Account (RRSP/ TFSA/Cash) no fee



MUTUAL FUNDS AS INVESTMENT VEHICLE

- Pooled "shared" funds
- Actively managed
- Incredible diversification
- Broker/Dealer/Bank
- Proportional "units"



ETF AS INVESTMENT VEHICLE

the brother who goes to the gym

- Market index
- Passively managed
- Incredible diversification
- Stock exchange (ticker)
- Proportional "shares"



INDEX FUNDS

hybrid between a mutual fund and an ETF

- underlying investments are index (passively managed)
- purchased broker/dealer/bank, units (not shares)
- MERs are often lower than mutual funds
- ...but higher than ETFs
