| 8/20/12 | | <p>Vancouver woman dies in motorcycle accident Updated: Aug. 21, 2012 at 10:56 p.m. PDT ROOSEVELT – A Vancouver, Wash., woman died early Monday afternoon when the motorcycle she was riding on crashed on Highway 14, 13 miles east of Roosevelt, the Washington State Patrol said.</p> <p>Troopers identified the woman as Gloria Edwards, 61. Edwards was thrown when the rear tire failed on the 1982 Honda Goldwing motorcycle. She died from internal injuries, the state patrol reported.</p> <p>The motorcycle was driven by Mark Edwards, 57, of Vancouver. He sustained a broken shoulder and multiple broken ribs and was taken to Kadlec Regional Medical Center in Richland, the state patrol reported.</p> <p>The accident occurred at 1:45 p.m. as the motorcycle was westbound on Highway 14 in Klickitat County.</p> <p>The motorcycle, which was towing a small trailer, ran off the right side of the road and came to rest in the eastbound lane.</p> <p>The motorcycle sustained \$3,000 damage, the report said.</p> <p>Both were wearing helmets. | 3/11/12 | | <p>U.S. 97 reopens late Sunday after dust storm causes 20-car pileup (video)</p> <p>TOPPENISH, Wash. — A major dust storm south of town on U.S. Highway 97 led to a 20-car pileup, two minor injuries and the closure of a section of the road Sunday afternoon.</p> <p>Emergency personnel responded to the scene shortly after 1 p.m. and found a dust cloud that darkened the sky and reduced visibility to less than 2 feet in places. Washington State Patrol closed the road between mileposts 56 and 60, from Pumphouse Road to Larue Road near Toppenish, as firefighters and other emergency responders worked to get drivers out of the dust and rerouted.</p> <p>At the scene, there were seven ambulances and about 20 firefighters from four different Fire District 5 stations. State Patrol and Yakama Nation police were on hand, as well, helping reroute drivers along State Routes 22 and 221 and local roads.</p> <p>The road was reopened Sunday evening. (Tom)</p> | | | |
