10/3/11		<p>Traffic impacts on Hwy. 14 near Camas start today. Drivers will encounter rough pavement, narrowed lanes and nighttime single-lane closures on the westbound Hwy. 14 Camas Slough Bridge starting today, Oct. 3. Vehicles more than 10 feet wide will also be restricted on the bridge starting today, until bridge improvements are completed next spring.</p> <p>The bridge will be narrowed to two 11-foot lanes during the day while crews work behind concrete barriers. At night, crews will close one lane and flag traffic through the work zone. Drivers can expect up to 20-minute delays between the hours of 8 p.m. and 6 a.m.</p> <p>Crews will construct slightly wider bridge shoulders and install a median barrier across the bridge, in addition to grinding out old asphalt, replacing existing guardrail with updated bridge railing, and repaving the bridge. This work is part of the SR 14 Camas-Washougal Widening and Interchange project. 7/18/11		<p>Woman dies after car hit by cement truck near Camas Published: Jul 18, 2011 at 6:32 PM PDT Last CAMAS, Wash. – A Vancouver woman was killed in a multiple-car wreck Monday afternoon on the Camas Slough Bridge on SR 14, according to Washington State Police.</p> <p>Kali B. Oberg, 18, died at the scene from internal injuries after an eastbound cement truck's left tire blew out, causing it to swerve into oncoming traffic, hitting her 1994 Toyota Corolla and two other cars in the westbound lanes, police said.</p> <p>The accident happened just after 4:30 p.m. and officials closed the road between mileposts 9 and 14 until just before 10 p.m. A detour was set up through the town of Camas and back onto the highway at Union St.</p> <p>Four people were taken to the hospital, suffering from various broken bones. Everyone involved in the accident was wearing seat belts.</p> <p>The accident is still under investigation. (Tom)</p>	Tom

The wreck occurred at about 8:30 a.m.</p> <p>According to a crash memo from the Washington State Patrol, Eggleston was westbound on the highway when he crossed the center line while following a curve to the right. 2/4/11		Police and paramedics late Friday were at the scene of a fatal accident involving a pedestrian and vehicle on state Highway 14 near Pearson Field in Vancouver. The accident was reported shortly after 9 p.m. A man who was hit in the westbound lanes at the offramp to Columbia House Boulevard was pronounced dead at the scene, said firefighter-paramedic Kevin Stromberg of the Vancouver Fire Department. Washington State Patrol Trooper Steve Schatzel said the driver of a disabled pickup had stopped on the right shoulder. A second pickup, equipped to tow the first one, arrived. The driver of that vehicle had just hooked up legally required lights on the disabled pickup when he emerged from it and was struck by a car, Schatzel said. The car's driver stopped at the scene.
