## Fediaf packaging guidelines

FEDIAF believes that governments, industries and individuals have a collective responsibility to maintain a reasonable balance between the needs of the population and the need to protect the environment from imminent damage. FEDIAF and its members are committed to their responsibilities towards the environment. While responsible, the pet food industry strives to be efficient and is at the forefront of technology. This means that it can minimize resource usage while maximizing safety standards. Concerns over environmental and ethical issues have led to a number of voluntary policies in the industry and have encouraged efficient use of energy in the production of raw and packaging materials, in the manufacture and transportation of pet food. The industry is one of the oldest to do recycling. The use of by-products products from the human food industry not only prevents the need for final disposal but also financially efficient. Disposal reduces meat prices for human consumption and demand for human food chains. Skilled members convert by-products to value-added products, which ensure proper nutrition for pet populations. FEDIAF supports: The use of all efficient resources for the production of safe, palatable and nutritious pet food. Design, operation and maintenance of processes and plants responsible for minimizing environmental adverse effects on the local community and, in particular: Minimizing emissions into the environment To minimize unpleasant smell To improve the appearance of manufacturing sites and premises. The use and development of packaging, which makes fewer demands on inrespresible and disposable resources in a way, which causes minimal impact to the environment - all without losing technological or safety efficiency. Schemes for reduction, reuse, recycling and waste washing to reclaim energy. Only clear, unclear and not misleading consumers about the environmental impact of a particular product. FEDIAF aims to take care of itself and its members to be informed of the needs of the relevant European and national environment. In this regard, FEDIAF acknowledges that legislation to protect the environment should be based on strong scientific evidence. Where appropriate, this should be developed at the EU level to ensure compatibility with policies. SETTING HIGH STANDARDS Feeding pets with safe pet food - to ensure a healthy life - is the main objective of the European Pet Food Industry. This applies to the entire manufacturing process from the food ingredients/ addals to finished products. In 2001, FEDIAF adopted a set of internal standards, which companies adhere to prevent (rather than responding to) potential difficulties in the production process to meet their commitment to pet food FEDIAF'S GUIDE to GOOD PRACTICE Regulations (EC) No. 183/2005 on food hygiene recognises the importance of good hygiene practices and promotes the development of the EU and the National Guide to good practices to ease the interpretation and implementation of the EU legal framework. The Good Practice Guide to Safe Pet Food Manufacturing developed by FEDIAF places good practice on the safety and hygiene of processes and pet food products. This document is intended to be a practical and useful tool for pet food manufacturers to assist them in developing established pet food safety management systems and complying with legal requirements of safety and hygiene. The scope of this Guide covers the production, storage and distribution of wet pet food (e.g. cans, trays and bags), dry or semi-damp pet food and chewing dogs in Europe as well as third country imports to the EU. The target species covered by this Guide are as follows: cats, dogs, ornamental fish and birds as well as small animals (e.g. rats, reptiles, rabbits, etc.). Products destined for horses are excluded from the scope of this Guide. OTHER CONSIDERATIONS AND REGULATORY REQUIREMENTS Scope This guide excludes the production, storage and distribution of pet food medications. Considerations relating to quality aspects - not related to product safety & hygiene - is beyond the scope of the documents and can be found in the relevant certification code. This guidance does not replace the national regulatory requirements and is based on the full self-responsibility of individual pet food manufacturers using the following reference documents and legal acts: Current best practices in the pet food industry, existing European laws including European Parliament rules and councils laying out the need for food hygiene affecting pet food, Recommended International Code of Practice Hazard Analysis Requirements, CAC/RCP 1-1969, Rev. 4-2003 EN ISO 9001:2015 (E) and EN ISO 22000:2005 (E) Standard requirements developed by other stakeholders e.g. related business sectors, retailers. The European Union Commission (EU) acknowledges that the Code can be a useful way to achieve modern labeling objectives; they should place a provision that allows buyers to make the right choices and that the support control authorities in using a harmonious approach. Although such instruments are not included in Regulation (EC) No 1831/2003 on food additives and premixtures, claims in this sector are common practice. To ensure shared alignment and approach to Both Feed Business Operators (FBOs) and authorities, FEFANA

has decided to develop the EU Code of Practice on voluntary labeling details (claims) for feed additives and premixtures, in the view of fostering transparency, fair competition and predictability. Article 13 Regulations (EC) No 767/2009 on placing in the market and food consumption defines the following labeling: 'Labeling' means the attribution of any word, details, trademarks, brands, picnic items or symbols to the feed by placing this information on any medium that refers to or accompanying such feeds, such as packaging, containers, notices, labels, documents, rings, collars or the internet, including for advertising. Therefore, this allows Feed Business Operators (FBOs) to advertise their food products, including food addals and premixtures. However, in Article 13, the rules limit the concept of claims for feeding materials and compound feed: ... labeling and presentation of materials livestock and compound feed can draw special attention to the presence or absence of substances in feed, to certain nutritional characteristics or processes or certain functions associated with any of these ... (§2, article article Although this article refers to feed and compound feed materials, claims in other types of food are also common. Furthermore, Article 25 this regulation promotes the development and use of a good code of labeling practice to support the harmonious implementation of labeling requirements by FBOs, however blocking it to two specific codes, one for food that produces food and one for pet food. The term claim, not defined or referred to in Regulation (EC) No 1831/2003 on additive and premixtures of feed. However, it is applied throughout the Commission Regulations (EC) No 429/2008, when referring to the 'claimed' functions declared by the applicant. In this regulatory context, FEFANA found it appropriate to develop a specific Code of Practice aimed at harmonising the implementation of labelling by food additives and business operator premixtures for transparency, fair competition and for the sake of predictability. In this Code of Practice, the term voluntary labeling details are used and not a claim term, although it is understood to have the same meaning. To ensure as much alignment as possible throughout the European feed sector, all relevant codes used have been taken into account when developing FEFANA COP. This is a good code of practice for compound food labeling for animals producing food co-developed by FEFAC and Copa-Cogeca, and a good code of labeling practice for pet food developed by FEDIAF. Complement to these documents, the purpose of the FEFANA Code is: to enhance the suitability of labelling, and to bring a similar understanding of the rules applicable to voluntary labelling; As a result, all different types of feed are addressed.
