Accuse Othello of bewitching his daughter, falling in love with him and trying to arrest him. Desdemona assures her father that she is in love with Othello1.3.2.1.1. Brabantio tells Othello: She deceived her father and may kill you (1.3.293)1.4. Othello1.4.1. Married to desdemona in secret1.5. Desdemona1.5.1. Deeply in love with Othello1.6. The Duke1.6.1. Mediation between othello and Brabantio.1.6.2. Send Othello to Cyprus to fight the Turks1.7. Cassio1.7.1. Othello's Lieutenant 2nd Act 22.1. Iago criticizes that women are only good for sex2.1.1.1. Iago gets Othello to listen to his conversation with Cassio so that he can get Cassio to recount what happened between him and Desdemona5.1.2.1. He eventually becomes a farmer in Iago's plans.6.5. Roderigo6.5.1. Roderigo is rich and stupid young man who every action is driven by his infatuation with Desdemona. Iago uses this to obsess over his advantage by using Roderigo to execute his plans.6.6. The Duke6.6.1. As an admirer of Othello, the Duke of Venice plays an essential role in the first act, where he conveys Othello and Brantio's differences and sends Othello to Cyprus.6.7. Brabantio, a senator from Venice and Desdemona's father, is furious when he learns that his daughter has run away with the Othello moor. So furiously, he begs the Duke that Othello must have bewitched his daughter with witchcraft, and later warns Othello that Desdemona could cheat him as she did.6.8. Bianca, a prostitute and Cassio's lover, plays an important role in Iago's plan to convince Othello that Cassio and Desdemona are having an affair.6.9. Montano6.9.1.
